Something Everyone Should Know

The EPA has passed new regulations

The new EPA Lead regulations for contractors who Remodel, Renovate or Paint come into effect on April 22, 2010 Lead regulations. These new rules for Lead Safe Practices are meant to protect the public but can be complicated. To help with the confusion here are a few things you as homeowners should know about these new rules.

Q: Do these new regulations affect my home?

A: The new regulations apply to your home if it was built before 1978 and children regularly visit or live there. We recommend that any home pre-1978 with or without children follow Lead

Safe Practices. There is no such thing as being too safe.



Q: What are Lead Safe Practices?

A: Lead Safe Practices are sets of procedure for remodeling, renovations and painting to prevent the spread of lead dust and clean up any lead dust created by work on applicable building or homes.

Q: What should I be asking contractors?

A: Anyone who remodels, renovates, or paints in your home should be able to provide you with a certificate issued by the EPA that says their company is a certified firm. And remember that **Complete Restoration Services is a Certified Firm!**
